In January-March 2018, SUEK produced 28.6 million tonnes of coal. The increase in production was 1% in comparison with the same period of time last year.

In 1Q 2018 total sales volumes increased by 10% compared with the previous year and amounted to 31.7 million tonnes of coal and other products.

The volume of international sales increased by 10% and amounted to 14.2 million tonnes of coal and other products while the volume of sales of own products increased by 2% to 11.0 million tonnes. The main directions of international supplies are China, South Korea, Japan, Taiwan, the Netherlands, Poland, Spain, Turkey and Germany.

The increase in domestic sales was 10%. Russian consumers were sold 17.5 million tonnes of coal, 13.8 million tonnes of which were supplied to power generation companies.

SUEK is one of the leading coal mining companies in the world, the largest coal producer in Russia and the largest supplier to the Russian domestic market and exporter. SUEK's mining, processing, transportation and service facilities are located in eight regions of Russia.
